Recommended Recordings

For our final concert of the season we would have been enjoying The Brook Street Band, an ensemble of eleven players featuring violin and flute soloists. Raymond Waud has put together the following listening recommendations in connection with it.

<u>Bach - Orchestral Suites:</u> My current favourite is by the Freiburg Baroque Ensemble conducted by Gottfried von der Goltz. The 6 Suites are on a Harmonia Mundi mid-price 2-disc set (HMC 90213/4).

<u>Handel - Sonata a cinque in B flat major:</u> This recommendation on Harmonia Mundi HMU 907415 (full price), with the Academy of Ancient Music under Richard Egarr, may be difficult to obtain at the moment, but a download is available, at medium price, from dealers like Presto Classical.

<u>Geminiani - Concerto Grosso in D major:</u> A superb CD with the title "London Calling" comes from BIS-SACD-1997 (full price). The recording quality is excellent, and the CD is performed by Baroksolisten conducted by Bjarte Eike. Works by Handel, Corelli and Veracini complete the disc.

<u>Handel - Concerto Grosso in D minor:</u> Christopher Hogwood with the Handel & Haydn Society give splendidly vigorous performances on Decca 458 817-2 (2 at medium price).

<u>Muffat - Sonata no. 5 in G major:</u> Armonico Tributo is performed by Ars Antiqua Austria conducted by Gunar Letzbor on Pan Classics PC 10407 (full price).

<u>Bach - Brandenburg Concerto 5:</u> Trevor Pinnock directs superb performances of all 6 with the European Brandenburg Ensemble on Avie AV2119 (2 at medium price).

All the recordings by the Brook Street Band on the Avie label are recommendable, and very well recorded. Three of my favourites are:-

- Handel-Trio Sonatas Op.2. Avie AV2282
- Handel-"Oxford" Water Music, etc. Avie AV0028
- J.S. & C.P.E. Bach-Sonatas for Violin and harpsichord. Avie AV2321.

75th Season (2020-2021) Concerts
