Cantelina: Sophie Clarke mezzo Ravi Nathwani guitar

Sophie Clarke is a 24 year old mezzo soprano and actor from Liverpool and has been awarded the Hargreaves and Ball Scholarship to study for a Masters degree in Classical Singing and Opera at the RNCM with Yvonne Howard and Louise Winter. She won the RNCM Song Cycle Competition for 2023. Performance highlights in recent years include alto soloist in Handel's *Messiah* in Nottingham, the mezzo soprano soloist in Bernstein's *Mass* conducted by Marin Alsop at the Royal Festival Hall, and singing in the world premiere of Wigglesworth's *Magnificat* in Bergen conducted by Edward Gardner. In 2023, Sophie will perform the role in Bernstein's *Mass* again, this time for the Manchester Premiere at Bridgewater Hall.

Born in Reading, **Ravi Nathwani** is an exciting young British Asian guitarist currently studying for a Master's degree at the RNCM under guitarist Craig Ogden, supported by a Help Musicians UK Postgraduate Award. During his time at college he has performed extensively, giving solo and chamber performances at a wide range of venues. In the final year of his undergraduate degree Ravi was invited to perform *Rain* for soprano, flute, guitar and electronics, by the Icelandic composer, Anna Thorvaldsdottir in a festival dedicated to her music at the RNCM.

An accomplished chamber musician, Ravi currently has three duo collaborations: with violin, soprano and with guitar.

They are excited for what the future holds and for upcoming opportunities, including the performance of a world premiere with the RNCM's Brand New Orchestra.
